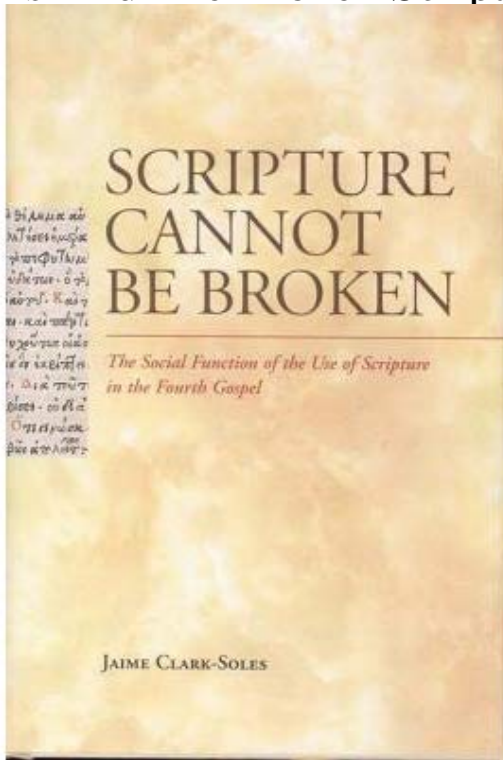


# Dickens And The Broken Scripture
