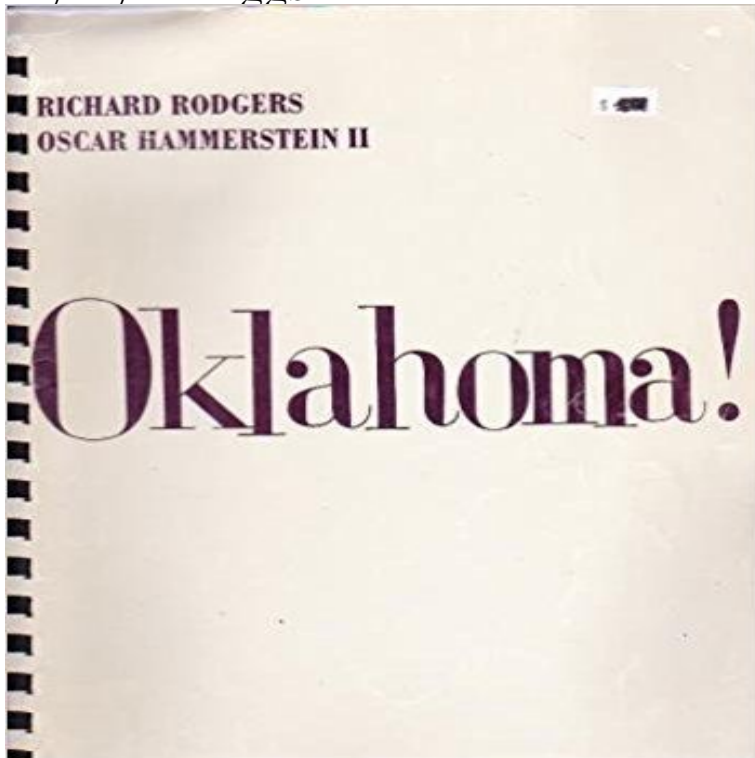


# Oklahoma!: A Musical Play Based On The Play Green Grow The Lilacs By Lynn Riggs
